3 independent levels working together

State

Ensures a police role, Implements the regulations & Authorizes

Water agencies & basins committees

Collects taxes and charges, Brings financial support,
Offers technical advice

Local authorities & economics users

Responsible for local implementation, project management


Public institutions of the Ministry of ecology

Main goal: achieve good chemical and ecological status for all surface, ground and coastal waters (EU water framework directive from 2000).

An economic system which collects taxes and grants subsidies for actions that preserve water resources and aquatic bodies

Geographical scope: Seine-Normandy watershed

A water stakeholders community, a shared challenge: save water!







Seine-Normandy watershed





- 18% of the national territory (94,500km²)
- 8664 municipalities
- 30% of the national population
- 55,000 km of waterways
- 640 km of coastline
- 40% of national industry
- 1/4 of national agriculture

The water agency collects

Taxes

In compliance with the « polluter pays » principle

- Pollution
- Withdrawals
- Others (fishing, protection products, obstacles, storage)

The water agency grants

subsidies

to basin stakeholders to:

- Fight against pollution financing new water treatment plants, improving sewage pipe's condition...
- Protect and manage water resources
- Enhance water resources knowledge
- To improve drinkable water pipes






The Seine










The sanitation system in Paris area







Heavy investments: storm basins and channels


















Investments costs



- 1 billion € investments (public and private)
- 80-90% for environmental purposes
- 10-20% only for bathing purpose
- Great progress in sanitation functioning (WWTP, basin storage, networks,...) and interaction between operators (SIAAP, Paris, Seine Saint Denis, Val de Marne,....)
- Great progress in sanitation networks, private misconnections (10 000 right connected),...
- Progress in depavement, vegetalization (150-300 ha disconnected from networks)
