



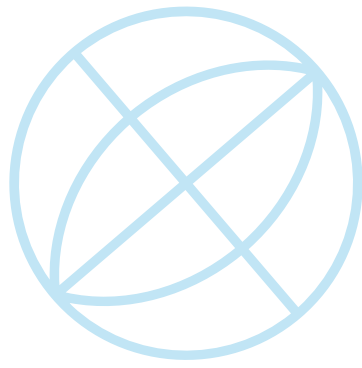

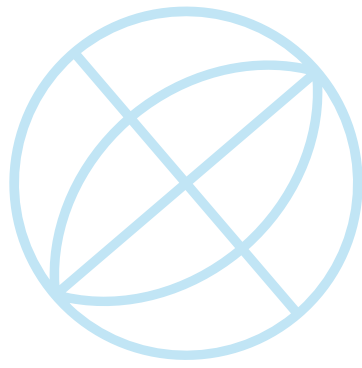

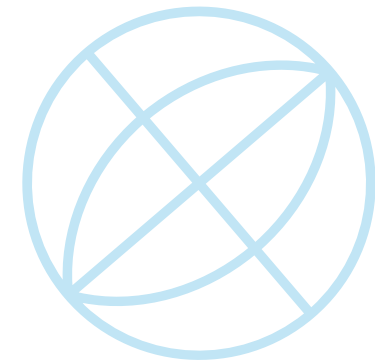

The greater Paris Metropolis



- The Greater Paris Metropolis was established on 1st January 2016.
- The Greater Paris Metropolis is a dense and urban area, which brings together the city of Paris, 123 municipalities in the three departments of Hauts-de-Seine, Seine-Saint-Denis and Val-de-Marne and 7 municipalities of Essonne and Val d'Oise.
- It was created through the Act for the Modernisation of Local Government and Strengthening of Metropolitan areas of 27th January 2014 and amended by the Local Administration Reform Act of 7th August 2015.



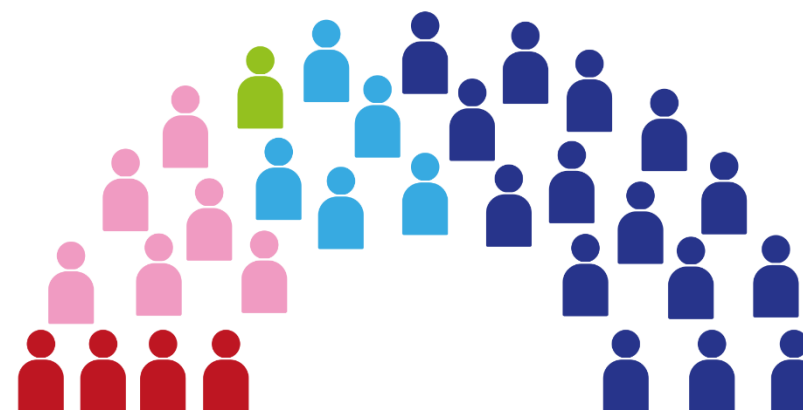
The Métropolis elected officials

- **The Council : 208 members**



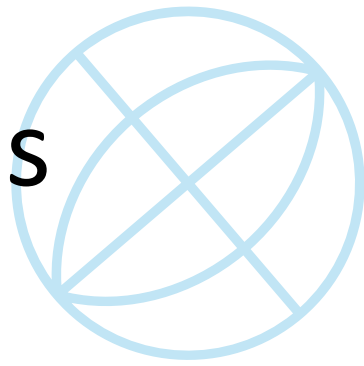

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5 major competencies for the Greater Paris Metropolis



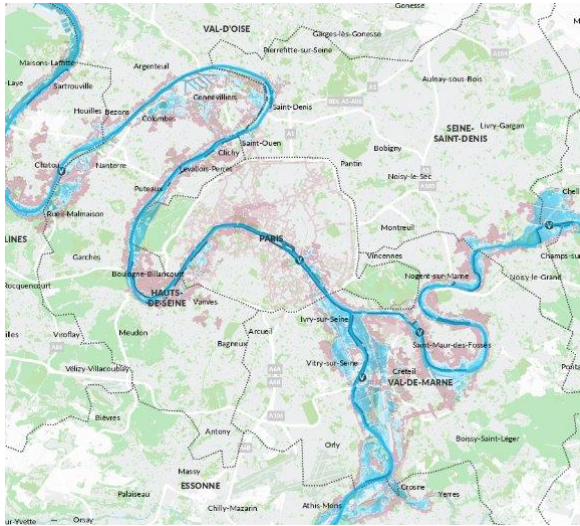
The Metropolis works toward economic, social and cultural development as well as planning, environmental protection and international attractiveness.

- 60Mrd € loss in Gross Domestic P

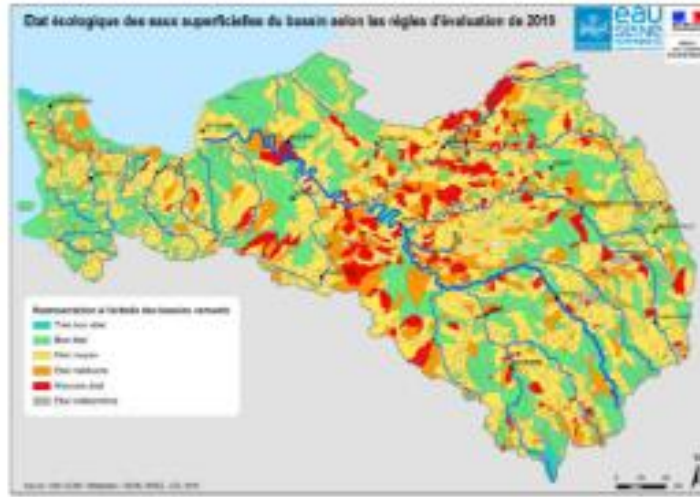


Figure 18 : Etat écologique des eaux superficielles du bassin de la Seine. Agence de l'Eau Seine-Normandie, 2015.

RIVERS Ecological quality

- 10 to 30% flow loss in 2100
- More extreme events floods and dryness
- Continuing hydromorphological pression on rivers (91% affected)

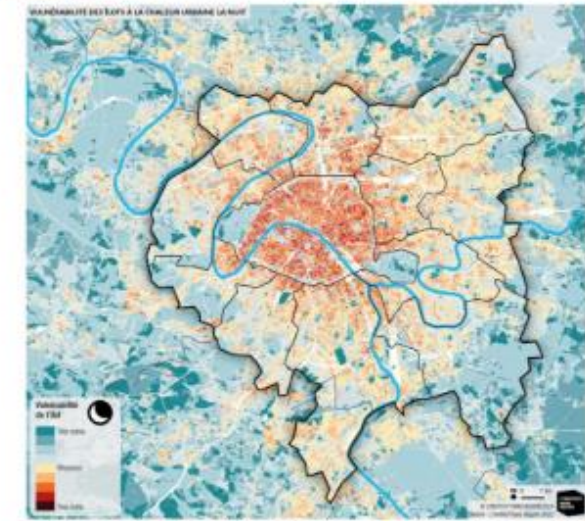
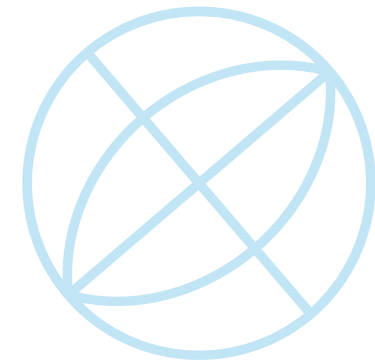


Figure 15 : Zones de la Métropole du Grand Paris vulnérables, la nuit, à l'effet d'îlot de chaleur urbain. Source : IFR 2024.

- 73 % of the population exposed

- Metropolitan energy air and climat plan , **PCAEM**
